

## Guidelines for Reopening the Masaajid on 13th Jun

Although the Government has announced that Places of worship across England are permitted to reopen for individual prayer from Saturday 13th June, the guidance does not allow for daily congregational prayers as well as Jumuah sermons. This means that the masaajid will have to remain closed for the five daily congregational prayers and Friday Jumuah prayer.

MJAH is eager for the full reopening of the masaajid for congregational prayers, therefore, we advise our affiliate masaajid and centres to stay on course for the original forecasted date of 4th July 2020, depending on the situation closer to the time.

No doubt, the Muslims community across the UK has shown great patience over the past few months with the closure of the masaajid, to help prevent the spread of Coronavirus and save lives. We now advise our communities to remain patient until the masaajid fully reopen for daily congregational prayers and other religious gatherings.
