

## Guidelines for Reopening the Masaajid on 4th Jul 2020

As the Prime Minister has confirmed the reopening of places of worship in England from Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July, MJAH welcomes and appreciates the government's decision. Based on the Prime Minister's announcement, we would like to advise our affiliate masaajid and centres in England to reopen on the announced date while keeping the congregation number up to maximum 30 people at a time, including at Friday sermons. As advised previously, if necessary, multiple congregational prayers and Jumuah khutbahs can be held.
